First Steps Internet Searching and Presentations

This course is ideal for learners with little or no experience of using the Internet to search for information. The course guides through going online to use a search engine to find specific information. The course also covers an introduction to making a digital presentation.

Digital Office Skills

Ideal for learners looking for an introductory course covering the basics of working in an office. Includes: using Microsoft Word templates, setting up and maintaining a budget sheet using Microsoft Excel, exploring expected admin skills, and, what to expect on the first day of working in an office.

First Steps Planning a Digital Photography Project

This course is ideal for those wishing to learn more about using their digital camera to improve their general photo taking. Put into practise learning concerning the exposure triangle, composition, lighting, camera settings and more. Aimed at bridge cameras and digital SLR cameras but also suitable to some extent for mobile phone cameras.

Next Steps Going Digital: Saving Money and Budgeting.

Ideal for learners who would like to improve existing digital skills to learn about saving money and budgeting.

First Steps Practical Word Processing and Presentations

Ideal for learners with a little Microsoft Word experience. The course builds on existing keyboard and general Word know-how by introducing the use of tables in a document to display information. The course's final session introduces further skills in PowerPoint to create a presentation.

First Steps Creative Photography and Photoshop Projects.

This course is ideal for anyone wishing to improve their digital image editing skills as well as learning/improving photography skills. You will be led through the initial steps of using a digital camera on its manual setting to take photos. The course embraces image compositing using the industry standard Photoshop package as well. Learn about non-destructive editing using the range of layer types offered within Photoshop. Some previous Photoshop experience required; some IT skills beneficial.
