This introductory course is ideal for learners with little or no computer experience. Subjects include: using the keyboard & mouse, Internet and computer safety, online shopping, using an Internet search engine to find information and using email.	Ideal for learners who would like to improve existing IT skills. Subjects include: advanced email, using comparison web sites, saving money online, digitally repairing a torn photo, making a digital slide show, an introduction to online office apps, and an introduction to using cloud technologies.
Beginners MSOffice	Intermediate MSOffice
Ideal for learners looking to learn new Microsoft Office skills or build on existing ones. Includes: digital file management and introductions to word processing, spreadsheets, designing desktop publications, and creating presentations.	Subjects include: advanced use of tables with word processing, getting to grips with formulas, autofill and charts with spreadsheets, and making a calendar and business cards with desktop publishing.
Advanced Microsoft Office	Digital Photography
This course is ideal for learners with some experience Microsoft Office experience. Topics include: using formulae in Word and Excel, advanced uses of PowerPoint and an in depth explanation of the differences between Excel and Access and the advantages of using an Access database instead of an Excel spreadsheet.	This course is ideal for those wishing to learn more about using their digital camera to improve their general photo taking. Put into practise learning concerning the exposure triangle, composition, lighting, camera settings and more. Aimed at bridge cameras and digital SLR cameras but not excluding smart devices.

You will be led through the initial steps of more advanced image compositing using the industry standard Photoshop package. Learn about non-destructive editing, animation, double exposures, recording actions and more. Some previous Photoshop experience required; some IT skills beneficial.
