<b>First Steps Internet Searching &amp; Presentations</b>	<b>Next Steps IT: Saving Money and Budgeting</b>
This introductory course is ideal for learners with little or no experience of searching for information on the Internet and of preparing a slide show presentation. Learn how to use a search engine to find information on line and use that information to create a presentation. Great for job hunters, researchers and general interest.	Ideal for learners who would like to learn more about saving money by using the Internet to search for money off deals and budgeting ideas.
<b>Beginners Practical Word Processing and Presentations</b>	<b>First Steps Digital Office Skills</b>
Ideal for learners looking to learn additional Microsoft Word skills or build existing ones. Learn how to format text, use styles, add images and develop a PowerPoint presentation.	This course is geared towards those who have some existing digital skills and would like to study towards the expectations of working in an office. The course includes using Microsoft Word templates, working between Word and Excel, identifying key work skills and what to expect on the first day of working in an office.
<b>First Steps Filtering Data in Excel and Access</b>	<b>Digital Photography</b>
This course is ideal for learners with some Microsoft Excel and Access experience. The course investigates when to use Excel and when to use Access with the objective of the effectiveness of filtering data in both apps, when to use a spreadsheet and when to use a database.	This course is ideal for those wishing to learn more about using their digital camera to improve their general photo taking. Put into practice learning concerning the exposure triangle, composition, lighting, camera settings and more. Aimed at bridge cameras and digital SLR cameras but not excluding smart devices.
<b>First Steps Advanced Photoshop (1)</b>	<b>First Steps Advanced Photoshop (2)</b>
This course is aimed at those with some knowledge of image compositing, layer masks, adjustment layers and layers in general. The course guides through creating custom overlays and the creative benefits available via the Camera Raw filter to adjust lighting. Some previous Photoshop experience of using layers, masks and adjustment layers preferred; some IT skills beneficial.	This course is ideal for anyone wishing to further improve their digital image editing skills. You will be led through the initial steps of more advanced image control to change/improve lighting of an existing photo via Levels and Curves, Highlights/Shadows adjustments and other techniques as appropriate. All completed using the industry standard Photoshop package. Some previous Photoshop experience required; some IT skills beneficial.
<b>Next Steps to Level 2 Maths</b>	
Corinth offers a range of non-accredited math courses that help you learn more around what's expected at GCSE level. This course guides you through some of the core subjects of level 2 math. Ideal for anyone who really wants to get grips with numbers.
